The next step is for us to review your answers and to decide if placing a puppy in your home and care is in the best interest of one of our pups. If so, and you are serious about acquiring one of our pups and giving it a LIFELONG home, we will forward a purchase agreement to you for your review and signature, and you will then forward the signed agreement via email, fax, or mail as well as a \$400.00 deposit paid via check (or cash if paid in person). Then you will be put on the puppy list in order of receipt of deposit. We will only accept a certain number of deposits and after that we start a waiting list, and in the event that less are born we will refund those people in order of last received or in the event more are born we will keep a waiting list and go in order of first added to list from time the deposit list was considered full.
